




## Victorian Multi Facet

Survey dimension sheet – all dimensions should be measured from inside. If possible measure in mm and give dimensions to the nearest 5mm. Watch the video to get tips on where to measure from.

	<p><b>Main Plan Dimensions</b></p> <p><i>The most important dimensions are the overall length and width of the space. Measure the width (X1) from fascia to fascia and the length (Y1) from the face of the house wall to the fascia.</i></p> <p>X1 = ..... Y1 = .....</p> <p>Y2 is the length of the side wall. Measure Y2 from the face of the house wall to the first corner.</p> <p>Y3 is the length of the second facet measured from the house wall. Measure Y3 parallel to the side wall.</p> <p>X2, X3 and X4 are the widths of the facets. Measure each distance between the internal corners as shown.</p> <p>X2 = ..... Y2 = .....</p> <p>X3 = ..... Y3 = .....</p> <p>X4 = .....</p>
	<p><b>Heights</b></p> <p><i>In order to work out the full area of the roof we need the vertical dimension to the bottom and top of the roof. Measure H1 from the floor to the top of the fascia and H2 from the floor to the underside of the ridge.</i></p> <p>H1 = ..... H2 = .....</p>
